Who should attend this free training:

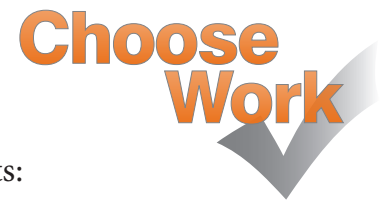
- Organizations that assist Social Security disability beneficiaries connect to work and careers; and
